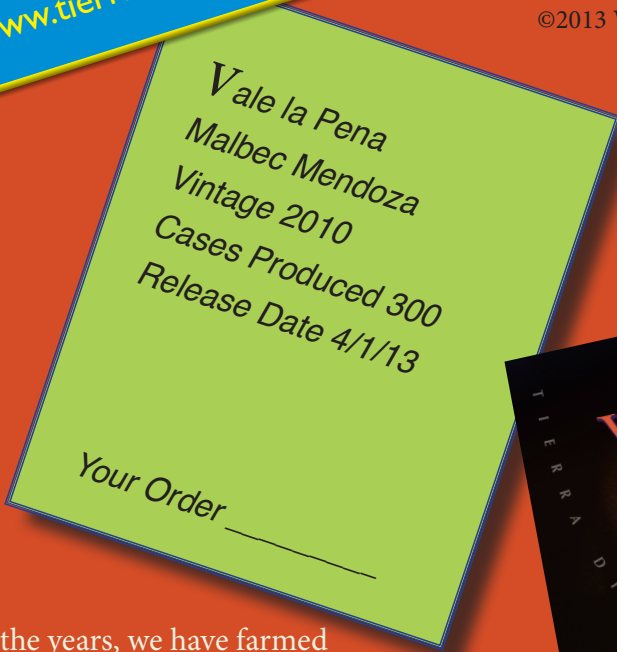
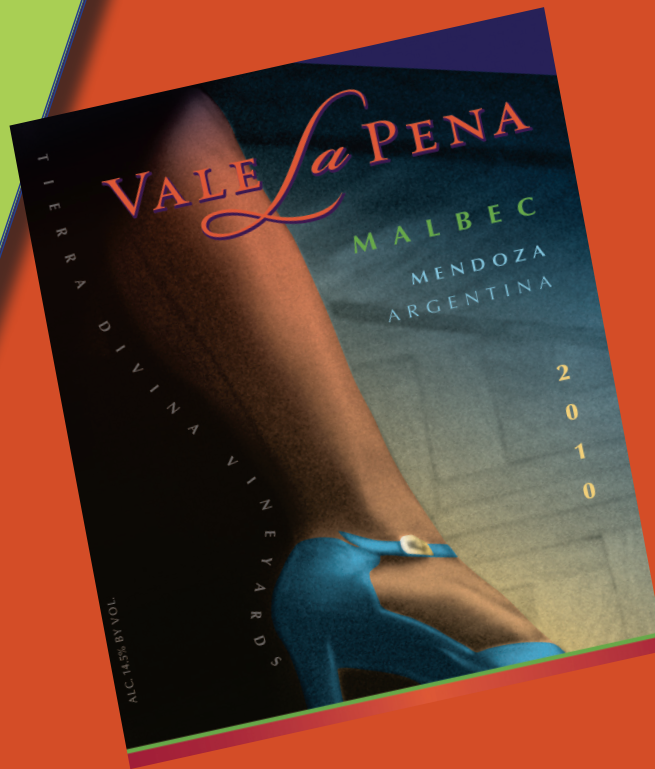


# WORTH THE EFFORT
